
third year of Bible College training at Carolina Bible College. Please keep him in your prayers.



Since joining the church, their landlord, who is a devout Buddhist and also provides a farming job for U Maung, has fired him from his job of many years and kicked them out of their house. They are now sleeping on the floor of the church. The church has a little bit of extra land where a small house can be built. The pastor is asking if we can raise \$800 to build them a house and they will become the caretakers of the church property. If you would help us with this need, we would love to help them.

2025 Church Planters Conference

We must begin raising funds for our Fall Church Planters Conference which takes place in November. We will have between 35-50 church planters attend this conference. It is my desire to be able to gift each of these pastors \$100 to help their families. This would cover their travel expenses, and hopefully provide for their families a needed blessing. My travel, lodging and rental expenses will be around \$3000. If you would like to help with this conference, we would greatly appreciate any help you could provide. Please pray continually for our orphanage ministries. We have seven in Myanmar and one in Thailand. We are so limited in what we can do right now, but we do all we can. They are in constant need of food, clothing and school supplies. Pray for the needed funds to be able to do more to help these ministries. Rice is \$80 per sack in Myanmar and \$60 in Thailand. Rice is their staple food.

As always, we want to thank those of you who faithfully partner with us, both financially and in prayer. We need you greatly during these days. Please continue to pray for His touch on our lives, to use us for His glory. Pray for the much needed personal support to increase, as well as the work funds, so we can continue having compassion and making a difference in Southeast Asia.
