Seeing Hope Rekindled

'Hope, where there was None!'

Seeing Hope rise up in the lives of young people around us, is so encouraging! We praise God for the sponsors of our Passion kids and for all those who pray and support the Passion Center--you all make the spreading of 'Hope' possible. Our driving goal is to see every Passion Child come to know the God of hope and that He would fill them with all joy and peace as they believe in Him and walk in His power- (based on Ro 15:13).

One powerful illustration of Hope being rekindled comes from Joseph and his recent test results. Joseph M. scored one of best National level Exam results we have ever seen!

But that didn't seem possible after his father passed away when he was young and his mother struggled to provide for their daily meals. Though he qualified for Secondary School, he had no one to pay for the tuition, books and fees. His live reached a standstill with little hope of continuing his education. That was before Joseph became a Passion Student and he had a sponsor to pray for and support him.



Through hard work, persistence and prayer Joseph went back to school. Thanks to the encouragement and coaching from the Passion Education and Ministry staff, Joseph amazed everyone with his results. He now is ready to apply to Medical school, full of hope that God has a future for him and that he can be a blessing to others!

The students in our newest Vocational Training Class represent another example of young people rediscovering hope when it seemed all opportunities for a future had died. So many young people in Malawi don't have the opportunity or ability to continue their education and therefore face a difficult future without a skill or trade. What an honor it is to provide a real wage-earning trade and tools through our Vocational Training Center all in the name of Jesus! Here's just one example from the 31 students in the Class.

Chrissy is a beautiful 24-year-old who grew up in the Passion Center program. She was just 8 years old when she came into the Passion family. She often struggled with school but always gave it her



all and worked hard. She just couldn't pass to go further. She faced a bleak future. And this past year was difficult for her, but by God's grace, her story doesn't end there. Now she has an opportunity to learn tailoring which will give her a way to support herself and her precious baby boy!

New Family-New Hope-New Possibilities

We are pleased to announce that Baby Chisomo now has a forever family!

It's been an honor and blessing to care for baby Chisomo at our Chikondi Home, but now she is going to a safe, loving family identified by the government Social Welfare Office. The Court granted an order to allow the couple to bring Chisomo into their home.

We rejoice that though Chisomo started off life abandoned in a pit latrine, she now has a family that wants her and desires to raise her as their own!

Of course, we are a little sad that Chisomo is leaving the Chikondi Home and that we won't be able to see her grow from a new-born into a healthy little girl or boy, like the others at Chikondi. But our main desire is that all of our Passion children come to know the safety and love that only God can provide either through a new Malawian family, their present family or the extended Passion Center family.



Chikondi Home Coordinator, Blessed shared this: "All in all it's been a wonderful time to be with her at Chikondi, and I'm grateful that I and the nannies have been part of her life's story in a positive and impactful way." Please join us in continuing to pray for Chisomo and her new family on this new journey!



Two quick additional Chikondi updates:

1) Baby Dalitso is our newest Chikondi infant! His mother was admitted to the Zomba Mental Hospital when she was 2 months pregnant with Dalitso. After delivery it was determined that the Mental Hospital wasn't a safe place to raise a baby plus his mother sometimes refused to care for or nurse the baby. The

grandmother came and took the child, but shortly after contacted the District Social Welfare Office pleading that Dalitso be placed at the Chikondi Home while the court sorts out what to do next. What a blessing to be a blessing to Dalitso!

2) We might have an opportunity to purchase a plot of land near the Passion Center that would be an ideal location to build our very own Chikondi Home! That will allow us to increase the number of vulnerable babies we're able to take in. We not only need our own place, we also need to set up the Home in the way needed for more Infants. Please keep this need in prayer.
