All of us around here are well because of His great mercy every morning, although there is a saying in the United States, which goes like this: Sometimes when it rains, it pours. To explain more, first the church bus broke down at the end of August - the turbo, the cylinder head, and the air conditioning. My wife had kidney stones, our son Lucas got really sick, the house we are renting had an electrical surge of power which fried 3 fans, the refrigerator, a few outlets, and 2 lamps. All of this happened within one month. My first reaction to all of this was, "Glory to God" and then I was praying, "Lord, help me and show me where we are going wrong so that we can confess and forsake our sins, shut the mouth of the enemy, and glorify Your name through all of these trials." Thank you for reading our light afflictions that are definitely not to be compared to the glory to come (Romans 8:18). For this reason we want to thank you for each of your prayers to the Lord on our behalf. We appreciate it and they are most needed. Thank you!

We will move on to the most important thing which is the transforming power to each person who truly receives Jesus in their heart. We thank God for door knocking. We met a young man named Benley, who had an accident in a cave in the mountain where pieces of rocks fell on his back leaving him unconscious. He has a broken back and spent 3 months in a children's hospital in Santo Domingo. His mom is dead, his dad abandoned him, and only his older brother watches over him. They have no money and Benley lives off of what people give him on the street. On December 8th he will turn 13. Now Benley has a new birthday - Monday October 7th, he received the Lord Jesus as his Savior. His friend, Wilson, also gave his life to the Lord Jesus. Praise God! Please pray with us about Benley's needs. He doesn't have a wheelchair, he wears diapers, and we are doing our best to help him as we are our brother's keeper.

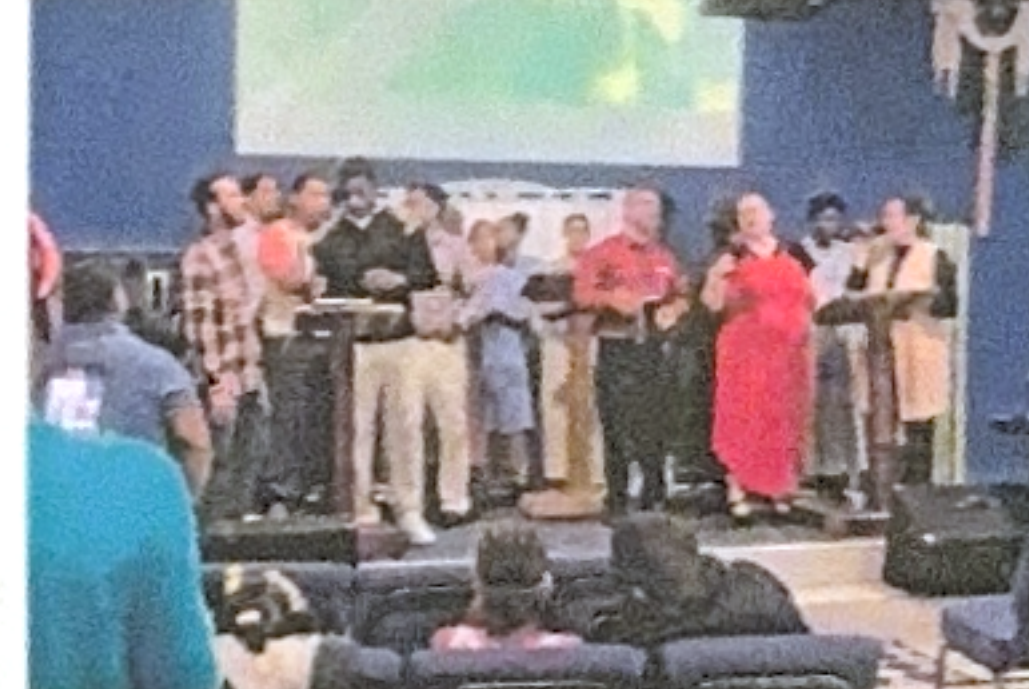
