Season of Hope and Thanks



So much to be Thankful For!

This year we've seen God prove once again that He is a tireless Rescuer, a loving Redeemer and a mighty Restorer!

It's a privilege to share with you, our friends and partners, some highlights from this year. Ministry partners like you make it possible for the Passion Center to continue extending God's grace and hope in the villages of Malawi.

Salvations: Through various outreaches and activities, a total of 4,075 people came to Christ.

Those Key activities included home visits, afterschool programs, VBS outreaches, sporting events (including the annual Passion Cup) and various conferences. We thank



God for allowing us to labor in this Harvest field.

Community Health Network: Through the Community Health Network (CHN) ministry, our staff and volunteers reached over 1,916 villages in some of the most vulnerable communities. These patients received spiritual encouragement, first aid medical care, transportation support to access medical treatment at various hospitals and heard the gospel all in the name of Jesus. Through monthly capacity building trainings and Health Professional mission Trips, we continue to equip our 150 volunteers. We also added a new CHN site in a predominately Muslim community.

Expansion of Early Childhood Development (ECD): One key highlight was launching the ECD ministry to 3 new church sites: Namikango, Jali and

Megowi. 146 vulnerable children are now receiving spiritual, educational and nutritional care in the mighty name of Jesus! This expansion provides



each church the strategic opportunity to impact their communities with the gospel and education.

Vocational School graduation: We held two more graduations this year, bringing the total number of students trained and graduated to 48. This is an awesome milestone in our quest to provide quality

hands on vocational skills training AND equipping each vulnerable youth with the Start Up Tools they need. This Training is critical for Youths not able to continue their schooling.

Education: Secondary School and College/University graduates - This year we celebrated the graduation of 4 more Passion Center

College students. Their fields of study were Agriculture, Nursing and Medicine. Also, more than ever before, our Secondary Students are now graduating and



qualifying for College! We're excited about seeing more become Teachers, Nurses, Doctors, Lawyers, and community leaders!

House Dedications & Handover: This year, we continued to rebuild collapsed Homes. We handed over 3 new Homes to our Passion kids and Households. These houses provide critically needed refuge and protection and symbolize the hope we have in Christ, and His love for the least of these.

Tree Planting Project: At the start of the year, we launched our first large scale tree planting project. We planted over 3,500 trees at our ministry sites and churches. In a country devasted by deforestation, we want to help reverse that trend.



Passion Center for Pastors (PCP) graduation and Swahili language Bibles: We held two graduations

this year- graduating 437 pastors and church leaders. 118 at our Ulongwe location and 319 from the Dzaleka Refugee Camps. Through a generous donation from a Passion Center Partner, we



were also able to distribute all Dzaleka graduates their own Swahili language Bibles.

Emergency Relief Food Project: Earlier this year

we responded to the national hunger situation by providing over 90 tons of emergency food relief. We're thankful for the generous support of our partners!



Girls Corner Graduation: As our focused ministry to girls in remote villages continues to grow, we held our first ever graduation of the Girls Corner ministry program. 35 girls successfully completed the training which focuses on the many daily challenges an orphaned young girl faces, as well as providing mentorship support to teen girls to reduce the risk of school drop-outs, early pregnancies and marriages at a young age. We want to expand this ministry to more areas.

Expansion of Mothers Sewing Group program: we expanded the Mothers Sewing group program to 3 new church sites: Chinduzi, Hope in Mangochi

and Faith in Mulanje.
A total of 45 women were enrolled in a 6 month sewing class with business training and discipleship. This brings the total of groups to 6. We're



praying to add 3-5 new groups next year.

- Desk Donation at Mulunguzi Primary School: As part of our 20th Anniversary celebrations and follow up project, we donated a total of 150 desks to Mulunguzi Primary School our long-time partner school. This was a timely investment for a school which has 1,560 students but only had 8 desks. Sadly, the lack of desks is a common situation in most village schools.
- Church Plants: Our recent Church Plants continue to grow and impact their communities. Two permanent Worship Centers were constructed this

this year at Megowi CC and Faith CC.

And another Church Plant was launched in the town of Chiradzulu- Bible Community Church. Please keep all ten of our partner churches in prayer.




Christmas Catalog-The Gift of Hope!


