Plans for returning to the Philippines in February or March of next year are still tentative. Please pray for us (and the other preachers) to know the will of God in this. People are open to the Gospel there, and the needs are great.

Doyle is suffering from Long Covid with fatigue and memory problems. It has been five years, and while there has been some improvement, it is very difficult and daunting at times. Even in this, God has proven to be faithful by anointing and using His servant to advance His Kingdom. Please keep Doyle in your prayers.
