They come to see their younger siblings, cousins, etc. who are current students. I love being able to see them, talk to them about their lives, and catch up on what they are doing. Many of them specifically look for me at this event, just to tell me about much they miss my class or our school or even our rules! I love to hear about where God has led them.

One of the last things I did before Christmas was get Christmas gifts for my bus kids. Some of them have been faithful all year long, so I decided to do something extra special for them. They got their very own Bibles for Christmas! Andres and his brother were especially happy. Andres made a profession of faith over a year ago, but has never had his own Bible. However, he carefully copied the memory verse out of someone else's Bible each week so he could work on it. He couldn't stop smiling after he opened his gift!
