It was such a good turnout that we picked up our first missionary as a church Jorge Lopez is just getting started in Nayarit, Mexico. which we are also planning to go to visit him in an evangelistic crusade in January. Also had the opportunity to attend a couple of mission conferences myself in two different locations in Texas, at which one of the churches we mentioned the need for a more reliable traveling vehicle, as we are trying to reach the many different ranches and villages in the state of Durango. Thus, I am glad to report that God used that little church in San Antonio to provide a good, reliable, and appropriate size for the crew. The work in "El Oso" (The Bear) is still going. It has now been a year of faithfully going once a month the people there are growing slowly but surely. Last week, we were able to do a quick trip to a village called "la Puerta" (the door), about a three-and-a-half-hour drive, where we handed out several tracks and planted the seed, and had a couple get saved. The prayer is to be able to reach more without leaving the first church plant un-attendant. we are now running around 50 folks who have been very faithful in their attendance and service. I am thrilled with the spiritual growth that they have shown. As we share the gospel with others without hesitation and very sincerely, they jump in to share what God has done for them. In another note, we also had the second family conference, and we had the honor of having missionary David West preached to us, which was a tremendous growth for our folks.

Thank you for another year of your faithfulness. Words do not do justice to our gratitude. Thank you for placing food not just on my table but on several others' tables as well. Thank you for filling our gas tanks so we can take the precious seed to different places, on behalf of every soul that was saved, and every life that was changed. Thank you for your sacrificial giving.
