We had 267 patients the first day and 280 the second day. The best part is that we gave free Bibles and gospel tracts to those who asked for it and we had 7 people make a profession of faith in Jesus Christ.

Every year we try to share Christmas dinner with members of the church and guests; we have many visitors, but the best part was to share the greatest story ever told of Jesus and His love. Thank God for the people who donated to make this dinner possible, and all the gifts given to the kids. 60 backpacks were given out with toys and games, 30 bags of food for families in need, and clothing as well. Only the Lord knows that some people that we come in contact with do not have anything financially they can give but God provides all that we need so that we are able to be a blessing to so many.

We also wanted to praise the Lord for how our daughter, Gabriela (Gabi), has taken a leadership role in our church in Jarabacoa with our choir. She helps with the sound system, helps us stay organized and gets songs printed and organized into binders. We are grateful to see how God is working in her heart and life. Lucas is getting ready to graduate in June and we are enjoying spending time with him before the Lord calls him to his next chapter in life (possibly in the States). We do ask for prayers as we get closer to graduation because it gets harder and harder as the kids leave.
