Malawi faces a challenging shortage of orthopedic services and materials for amputees, leaving thousands without proper care or hope. The need is greatest in rural villages, where over 80% of the population lives. A well-fitted prosthetic transforms daily life, providing independence and gives hope.

On our recent Mission Trip, we were moved by the chance to connect with individuals facing amputation. Brent from Life and Limb Restoration generously shared his skills and trained others. Meeting Dan was a highlight—his story of overcoming loss and finding strength inspired fellow amputees to hold onto hope. The sense of hope was visible in the faces of many as they learned they were not alone. It was a joy to witness new optimism and to share the Gospel with each person and their family. Training and measurements went well, and Brent's team will start making prosthetics to deliver this summer. A Family Story of Hope & Rescue

In June 2024, our Community Health Network (CHN), encountered a family whose need was urgent. Six children, orphaned and facing daily hardship after their mother died, leaving the youngest less than a year old. Their frail grandmother struggled to care for them, leaving the children with little choice but to beg on the streets for food.

The very week this family came to our attention, the Chikondi Infant Rescue Home was opened and Jummah, only two years old, was rescued and brought into safety. Once bathed, fed, and settled into a warm bed, his transformation was immediate and striking.

Within months, three of Jummah's siblings—aged 4, 7, and 9—were welcomed into Passion Center residency and enrolled in school. The following year, the two oldest siblings, ages 16 and 18, joined our Vocational Training Center to learn practical trades. Christina trained in tailoring, while Umali became a bricklayer. Most importantly, the family was finally reunited, seeing each other regularly.

Though raised Muslims, Christina and Umali heard about and saw the love of Jesus in action all around them. In a short period of time, both placed their trust in Jesus as Lord and Savior. Recently, Christina and Umali were baptized, surrounded by their younger siblings! We give thanks for God's rescuing, redeeming and restoring these precious children!
