Still Making a Difference in Myanmar

Hope Baptist Church serves as our foundational ministry in Yangon, Myanmar under the leadership of our Burmese National Director—James Lova. The Lord allowed them to celebrate their 10th Church Anniversary in April. Due to the military coup and corruption of the government, we were not able to join in their celebrations personally but praise the Lord with them for His blessings. Together, the Lord has allowed us to start 46 ministries in Myanmar including churches, schools, orphanages and livelihood training centers. Since the coup took place, they have been redistricting the country. They now have 121 districts whereas they had 64. However, our vision and goal has not been deterred, only enlarged. We still want to plant a church in each district of Myanmar.
