At the beginning of the World Cup, we were able to travel to Mexico City with a team to distribute nearly 25,000 John and Romans Gospel tracts along with Scripture contains in several different languages. We are thankful for the opportunity to share the Gospel with so many people.

Please pray for the city of Durango. The governor is under investigation, and the Mexican government has deployed more than 900 soldiers into the city something that has never been seen here before. Several bulletproof vehicles have been confiscated, and thankfully there has only been one confrontation. Please pray that God would continue to protect the people and bring peace to the area.

Please also pray for Luna, a 4-year-old girl from our church. Doctors have discovered a tumor in her chest and have given her only a 5% chance of survival if she undergoes surgery. We ask that you join us in praying for God's healing hand, wisdom for the doctors, and comfort for her family.

The property we have been praying about has moved forward. We were able to come to an agreement, and the paperwork is now in process. Lord willing, construction will begin sooner rather than later. We are grateful for how God has provided every step of the way.

It has been an honor to help in several camps and special services throughout Mexico. One of these was in Torreón, about three hours away, where I had the privilege of preaching each night. During those services, six people trusted Christ as their Savior. At our church, three more believers have followed the Lord in believer's baptism.

In July, we celebrated our 4th church anniversary since starting the mission. We had a wonderful turnout and were blessed with Spirit-filled services. Several guest preachers came to help throughout the meeting. The highlight was having veteran missionary Pastor Robert Hawk preach the final message of the conference. We thank the Lord for His continued faithfulness and for all He has done over these past four years.
