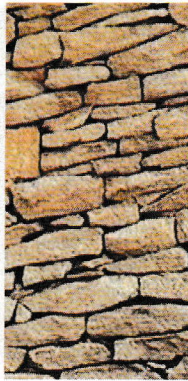
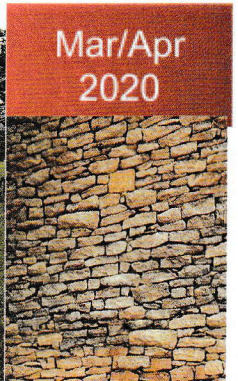

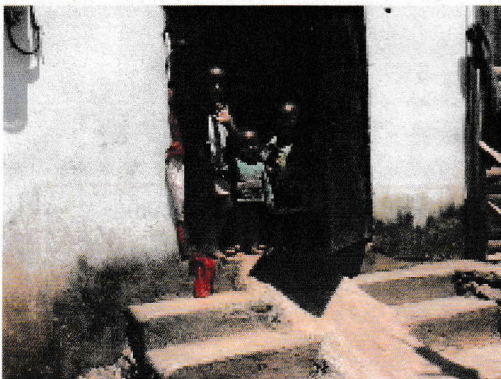


The Concepcion Family – Your missionaries in the ...

Well, the last time we met at the church was 3 weeks ago and we had the Lord's Supper together, but a closed door service because we didn't have permission to meet in the church.

We greet you with thankfulness in our hearts for all that you do for us during this time of madness. We never dreamed of living and watching a world be paralyzed by a micro-parasite as the COVID-19. The news arose early here in the Dominican Republic, where in the beginning of March, all the schools, businesses, churches, and all travel were closed and the whole country was put under a curfew until all of this is over. Enforced by the President and carried out by the military, we are in total lock-down from 6am to 5pm every day - no exceptions. We haven't seen very many people full of fear and worried about their lives, but we have seen others mock the authorities and laugh at this pandemic.

We know that all of this took many people by surprise and many of you, like us, see this change as painful and difficult but we want to encourage you in the Lord. In Psalm 91:1-7 we read so many promises from God that we do not need to be afraid. We have so many reasons in this Psalm to be joyful, secure, and at peace with our Savior Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

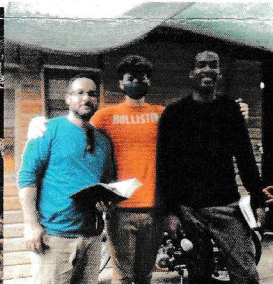
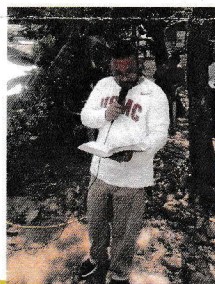
