The Church:

The church is going great! We are very thankful for all that God has been doing. As the church continues to grow, we give all Glory to God! As many of you may know from past letters, we have been without a translator for a year and a half. During this time we have done our best to communicate and teach the Word of God in the Albanian language. However since this language is very difficult, we still felt the need for a translator. Well, once again we can report that God has answered our prayer! We now have a translator to help in our ministry.

Tent / Hospital Ministry:

The first tent meeting was scheduled for April 3-5, but that has been postponed until a later date due to the difficulties that we are temporarily facing because of the Covid-19 virus. However, as we began to explain to our church what a tent meeting was, they became very excited about our first meeting. They have never attended church outside under a tent. I can remember the first tent meeting I ever attended in Baldwin, FL hosted by Bro. Dean McNeese.

What God did in my heart under that tent as a 17 year old boy, I will never forget. My prayer for this tent ministry is to see God save and change lives forever. I pray that what God does under this tent will last in the hearts and minds of these people for years to come.

The hospital ministry has been a great blessing. As we walk through the hospital passing out hygiene bags and gospel tracts, I can't help but think how blessed we are and how much we take for granite. Sometimes we forget to be thankful for little things such as toilet paper and hand soap. It truly blesses my heart to see the faces of people light up with joy as they receive this gift from the church. We would like to say thank you to all those that have given to help make this ministry possible. I want to quickly mention that this ministry has also been temporarily put on hold due to the virus. As soon as things clear up and go back to normal, both of these ministries will resume.
